## Madoc Skatepark



Come out and enjoy a day with the family at the Madoc Skatepark. The Skatepark is equipped with many facilities such as a canteen, a picnic pavilion, washrooms, a playground, and a 12 700 sq ft concrete Skatepark, as well as a 3500 sq ft concrete “bunny” park for you children and beginners.

The Skatepark is a very technical park, and is excellent for kids of all abilities. The "bunny" park for young children and beginners allows all types of equipment, including scooters and tricycles. The canteen, open May to Thanksgiving, serves non-alcoholic beverages, snacks, and a small variety of short-order meals. A picnic pavilion located near the bunny skatepark and the small children’s area of the playground provides shade over two 8-foot picnic tables. Several other picnic tables are located throughout the park taking advantage of sunny areas and cool, shady spots. The playground Mega Tower structure has 3 decks, 2 long tube slides, and great climbing features. The Tot’s Choice play structure provides safe climbing, sliding, and exploring for toddlers. Fully stocked and clean washroom facilities are located at the canteen. Women’s, men’s and family washrooms are available. The park is supervised from May to Thanksgiving weekend. BMX bikes, K2 Rollerblades, and skateboards can be rented for \$5/hour; however, daily rates on equipment for out-of-town visitors can be arranged at the Canteen

### Hours of Operation

The skatepark is open year-round from 7:00 a.m. until dark or 9:30

During the summer months (June – Sept.) late skates are held on Friday and Saturday nights (until 10:30 depending on the temperatures and number of participants)

The park (including the playground) closes each evening at dark

### Park Rules

1. This park is open from 7:30 AM until 9:30 PM or until dark. During the summer the park is open on Friday and Saturday night until 10:30 pm.
- 2 Only SKATEBOARDS, IN-LINE SKATES, and BMXs with maximum 20” wheels are permitted. Mountain bikes and scooters are prohibited.
3. BMXs must have pegs completely covered.
4. SMOKING, EATING, and DRINKING are not permitted on the skatepark. Glass containers are prohibited.
5. CSA approved helmets, knee pads, elbow pads, and wrist guards are strongly recommended.
6. No items such as benches, garbage cans, or tables may be used as ramps or jumps.
7. Spectators must watch from outside the skatepark.
8. This park is a drug and alcohol free zone.
9. Motorized vehicles are permitted only in the designated parking areas.

10. Use park at your own risk.
